UNIT of our college had organised a 7 days Special Rural Camp from 16th to 22nd December, 2019 at Kille Mahuli, Mahuli Village (Awale), Taluka Shahpur, District Thane. 54 Volunteers (33 Boys+21 Girls) along with 04 ex-volunteers and 2 N.S.S. Program Officers participated in the camp. Many activities were organised for Community Development and Awareness.

- **Forming Groups, Greeting Card Making & Swachh Bharat Abhiyan:**

7 Group of volunteers were formed for Kitchen Committee & Street Play on First day. Swachh Bharat Abhiyan was carried out at the camp site, in which volunteers cleaned the camp site area. Also volunteers made the Thanking Greeting cards for the Visitors and Resource Person.



- **Camp Site Visit for Bandhara & Seminar On Gender Sensitisation:**

Volunteers had visited the site for Bandhara Construction & A seminar on “Gender Sensitisation” was organized on the second day. The resource person was Mr. Pravin Thote from the NGO “MAVA”. He explained various issues related to gender sensitisation through games and various illustrations.



- **Bandhara Construction measuring 10m & 09m respectively & Visit to Zilla Parishad School:**

02 bandharas were constructed at different place in Mahuli Village. This was done in order to conserve the water for a longer time and make a proper use of the water in the future. Volunteers also visited the Zilla Parishad School & had interaction with the Children & staff members.
