



ANALYSIS OF FEEDBACK COLLECTED FROM STUDENTS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2021-22




From the above graph, it is very satisfactory to know that we have received the feedback from the students of all the streams where the major percentage of response is from the BCOM Department with 37.9%, 23.2% from Bsc IT 7.3% from the BMS Department and the rest from BBI, B.SC.IT, BMM and BFM Department.



From the above graph, we can see that we have received the feedback from the students of not just one year but all the three FY, SY and TY students where 63.8% responses is from the TYs, 7.6% responses is from FYs and 28.5% responses from the SY students.




From the above graph, it is evident that 52.8% of the students feel the depth of syllabus content is good enough, 35% students feel it is excellent, 11.3% students feel it is just satisfactory whereas the rest which are less than 1% are not very satisfied.






From the above graph we can see that 56.5% of the students feel that the objectives and relevance to the course content are good, 29.9% students feel it is excellent, 12.7% students feel it is satisfactory whereas the rest which are below 1% are not satisfied.

From the above graph we can see that 54.8% of the students feel good that the sequence of the courses that they have studied are in sequence to what they have studied in the previous year is good, 31.1% students feel it is excellent, 13.6% students feel it is satisfactory whereas the rest are not satisfied.
